For just \$12.00 a year you can “adopt” your own Animal Aid dog by becoming a “Pet Pal”. Your pal will continue to live at the shelter but will be your special friend.

You will receive a letter from your new pal, which includes some background information and interesting personality traits. The money you give will help provide food, shelter, vaccinations, medicine and treats.

You can visit your pal at 80 Butler Farm Road, Hampton and take your pal for walks on a leash and even bring your own special treats. The shelter is always open from 9 a.m.to noon seven days a week.

Our goal is to find each of our dogs its own home, so in the event your “Pet Pal” gets adopted, you will be notified and can make another selection or we will be happy to pick one for you.

Where else could you have such a “tail wagging” experience for just a dollar a month? So please help us care for these homeless dogs by becoming a “Pet Pal”. It’s a fun experience for both Pet and Pal.

If you plan on walking your “Pet Pal”, please come and sign an AAS Volunteer Waiver.
